

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The Provider Course is a training program designed for health care providers whose job responsibilities may require them to participate in neonatal resuscitation. This course has been designed to teach an evidence-based approach to resuscitation of the newborn. The causes, prevention, and management of mild to severe neonatal asphyxia are carefully explained so that health professionals may develop optimal knowledge and skill in resuscitation.

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) is based on the guidelines of the American Academy of Pediatrics, 2006.

## **PREREQUISITES**

For NRP Renewal:

- ❖ Must have a copy of your current NRP training card or written/signed verification by your manager of your current NRP status.
- ❖ LPCH/Stanford employees must submit NRP expiration date on LPCH registration form.
- ❖ Must be prepared, through text review, to complete process in time allotted.

**NRP COURSE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:**

Participants will learn...

- ❖ Changes in physiology that occur when a baby is born.
- ❖ Risk factors that can help predict which babies will require resuscitation.
- ❖ Decide if a newborn needs to be resuscitated.
- ❖ Resuscitate a newborn when meconium is present.
- ❖ Test and troubleshoot devices used to provide positive-pressure ventilation.
- ❖ Administer chest compressions.
- ❖ How to coordinate chest compressions with positive-pressure ventilation.
- ❖ The indications for endotracheal intubation during resuscitation.
- ❖ How to use the endotracheal tube to administer positive-pressure ventilation.
- ❖ How to administer epinephrine.
- ❖ Special situations that may complicate resuscitation and cause ongoing problems.

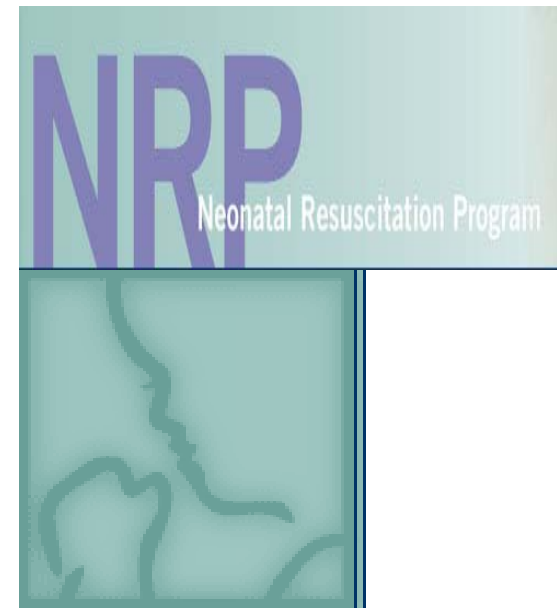
